We will hold International Amity Dance Competition (Madam Datin Lowe's Cup) Japan Dance Grand Prix 2018 , Amature Tokyo Dance Competition, E-JBDF Professional Rising Star Dance Competition.

1. Date & Time: Sunday, 14th October 2018

2. Venue: Kohrakuen Hall
3. Organiser: Japan Ballroom Dance Federation International
4. Chief organiser East-Japan Ballroom Dance Federation
5. Officially Recognized by National Dance Council for Japan (NDCJ/WDC)
6. Competition Details:
 - (1) Japan Dance Grand Prix:
For both sections (Standard and Latin), couples will be required to compete in all 5 dances from the Quarter-final. Competition will start from Latin section.
 - (2) Amature Tokyo Dance Competition
For both sections (Standard and Latin), couples will be required to compete in 4 dances in qualifying heets, 5 dances from the semi-final.
 - (3) Professional Rising Star Dance Competition
Rising Star Dance Competition (hereinafter referred to as Rising) will be done by Standard, Latin American, 2nd Subject.
7. Demotion regulations
 - (1) Grand Prix, Tokyo Dance Championship is an event competition subject to elevator class regulations.
 - (2) Although classification regulations are not applied to class-A at Rising appearance, Class D players will have one appearance count.
 - (3) If class A athletes can not participate in the event, please submit a missing report stating the reasons
8. Entry
 - (1) Japan Dance Grand Prix:
 - ① Eastern Japan is a professional D or higher competitor
 - ② Regional member bodies other than Eastern Japan are class B or higher competitor
 - ③ JDC · JCF registered players are 12 competitor in each section for each group
 - (2) Amature Tokyo Dance Competition
 - ① competitor over Eastern Japanese Amateur D
 - (3) Professional Rising Star Dance Competition
 - ① Eastern Japan Pro C, D grade competitor

13. Judging

(1) Grand Prix: The panel of adjudicators for Grand Prix Professional will consist of nine adjudicators (Three WDC/oversea adjudicators, Two JDC adjudicators Two JCF adjudicators and Two JBDF adjudicators.)

(2) Professional Rising Star; Independent examination each section. (WDC/oversea adjudicators)

(3) Amature Competition; The panel of adjudicators for Amature competition will consist of nine JBDF adjudicators.

(2) Amature Tokyo Dance Competition: ¥7,000 for one section

(3) Professional Rising Star: ¥5,000 for one section (Standard or Latin)

d. Eastern Japan should apply at once to the Competition Secretariat.

- (1) The top 12 couples in the national ranking, and the couples who danced the Final and Semi Final Round of the Balqua Cup 2017 will be seeded , and are exempt from the 2nd Round this year.
- ※ The exemptions only apply to the same partnership as existed in the aforesaid ranking or event, and not to the competitors individually. The semi-final prizewinner of three big competitions in Britain participates from the final qualifier as a seeded competitor.
